CastTec have been supplying quality cast-iron fireplaces and stoves to the UK heating industry for over 25 years. Using our long established foundries, which are renowned for quality castings and steel products, we would like to introduce you to the CastTec Stove Collection, a range of wood burning and multi-fuel stoves and fireplaces.

As well as being aesthetically pleasing, CastTec stoves are highly efficient (up to 80%) with low carbon emissions to comply with EcoDesign 2022 regulations and DEFRA exemptions allowing all of our stoves to be installed in smoke control areas.

CastTec stoves also benefit from Triple Burn Technology, consisting of a Primary Air Control, a Secondary Airwash Lever, and a Tertiary Air System (inlets inside the rear of the stoves which mixes pre-heated air with the exhaust gases causing the exhaust gas to re-ignite producing a cleaner and more efficient stove).


Our stoves are manufactured using only premium grade cast-iron and heavy gauge steel enabling them to be robust enough to last for many years when used with care and attention. For this reason we are confident to offer a conditional 10 year warranty covering your stove body (see conditions on page 46).

The CastTec Stove Collection also offers a range of beautiful cast-iron inserts, handcrafted marble, granite and limestone mantelpieces, elegant inglenook interiors, sturdy honed and polished granite hearths along with all the accessories you may need to complete your perfect fireplace. 

NEVIS EDGE



Designed and engineered to be efficient and kind to the environment, this 5kW freestanding stove has a multi-fuel grate that allows it to burn seasoned wood or smokeless fuels.

The mantelpiece shown is the Kensington in pure Spanish Crema Marfil marble. (Crema Marfil Gallery is shown on page 44 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40).

The fireplace chamber is lined with an oyster marble interior and the hearth below consists of Honed Black Granite in our Munro style (see page 45).

The Nevis T5 is a sister to our popular Nevis 5, bringing a slightly more traditional look yet the same specifications and robust performance. A multi-fuel grate allows the T5 to burn seasoned wood or smokeless fuels.


The Nevis range has a Tertiary Air Inlet which mixes pre-heated air with the exhaust gases, allowing the exhaust gases to re-ignite

producing a cleaner and more efficient stove.

The mantelpiece shown is the Chilton in pure Slate Stone (our Slate Stone Gallery is shown on page 43 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). The fireplace chamber is lined with painted vermiculite board and the hearth below consists of Honed Black Granite in our Munro style (see page 45).



NEVIS 8

The Nevis 8 is the latest part of our Nevis range, slightly larger than its sisters, and producing an impressive heat output of over 8kW for those requiring additional heat. A heat output above 5kW may require an air vent fitted in the room.

A multi-fuel grate allows the Nevis 8 to burn seasoned wood or smokeless fuels.

The mantelpiece shown is the very eloquent Hexham in Pure Turkish Limestone (our Turkish Limestone Gallery is shown on page 41 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40).

The fireplace chamber is lined with a Grey Slate interior and the stove is seen standing on a Honed Black Granite Hearth in our Munro style.

COUGAR 5

The Cougar 5 is an elegant cast-iron stove with a modern feel and robust performance. Designed and engineered to be efficient and kind to the environment, this 5kW freestanding stove is majestically curvy and has an Art Nouveau feel about it.

A multi-fuel grate allows the Cougar to burn seasoned wood or smokeless fuels.

The Cougar also benefits from triple burn technology consisting


of Primary Air, Secondary Airwash and Tertiary Air.


PUMA 5

The Puma 5 is a sister of the Cougar 5 stove shown on the previous pages sporting the same interior and therefore providing the same output and efficiency specifications. Externally the Puma is squarer in design and less curvy than the Cougar 5 but is equal in elegance.

A multi-fuel grate allows the Puma to burn seasoned wood or smokeless fuels.



HORIZON 5

The Horizon 5 is part of a family of quality multi-fuel steel stoves suitable for use with seasoned wood or approved smokeless fuels.

The simple design is perfect for the most contemporary or traditional setting. The Horizon is available with a Log Store option and the following pages show a wider version of this model, also available with a Log Store.

The Horizon 5 is shown with the Keswick shelf. This shelf is available in Solid Oak and stained to requirement or supplied without a finish. The Keswick has a shelf length of 1200mm (48") or 1350mm (53").

The Horizon stove is sitting on a Nevis honed granite plinth with an oyster marble inglenook panel to the rear.




HORIZON 5 WIDE

The Horizon 5W (or Wide) is the sister of the smaller Horizon 5 multi-fuel steel stove shown on the previous page. Both models have been tested and approved as 5kW stoves, however the 5W model is slightly wider in dimension allowing for a better view of the combustion chamber.

The Horizon 5W, like it's sister, is available as a free-standing model or as a Log Store model.

The Horizon 5W is shown inside the majestic looking Corinthian mantelpiece in pure Italian Carrara marble sporting a pair of exquisite acanthus leaf carvings (our Italian Carrara Gallery is shown on page 42 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40).




SIROCCO 5 / 7

The Sirocco is a sturdy cast-iron and steel stove with an attractive arched design and an extra wide window allowing for the maximum viewing potential. Our standard Sirocco model has a 5kW output, however, a deeper model is also available providing up to 7kW for those requiring additional heat. Note that stoves with a heat output over 5kW usually require additional ventilation in the room.

A multi-fuel grate allows the Sirocco 5 and 7 to burn seasoned wood and smokeless fuels.

The Sirocco, with a top or rear flue outlet, looks very contemporary in a setting without a traditional chimney, a dedicated twin walled flue pipe being used instead as part of a bespoke flue system.



CT5


The CT5 is a stunning cylindrical steel stove very much in the European tradition making the most contemporary of statements.

Designed for wood burning, the CT5 has a 5kW output, top or

rear flue outlet options, efficiency levels approaching 80%. and a log store attached. This model will look elegant in any situation and has the advantage of a large viewing area to enjoy seeing the flames dancing inside on a cold winter evening.

COUGAR INSET

The Cougar Inset Eco Plus is an attractive 5kW cast-iron inset stove sporting a large glass window to allow for the maximum view. A unique convection chamber allows cold air to enter below the stove and pass up through the chamber whilst warming up and then re-enters the room through vents above the stove door creating an increased efficiency.

The Cougar Inset is shown here inside a beautiful Mosaic ceramic tiled back panel.

The mantelpiece shown is the Flat Victorian in Honed Shanxi Black Granite. This mantel


is also available in a polished black granite finish (our Shanxi Granite Gallery is shown on page 45 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). The Flat Victorian mantel is also available in Italian Carrara marble or Turkish limestone.

The hearth shown is boxed and lipped in Honed Black Granite to compliment the design of the mantelpiece top shelf.

Hearths fitted with an inset stove should be sectioned to allow for expansion due to the intense heat generated by the stove.

POLARIS INTEGRA INSET

The Polaris Integra Inset is a 5kW cast-iron stove with an arch design which can be polished or matt black in finish. This model looks attractive by itself but also integrates uniquely with our stunning Integra cast-iron fireplace range shown on the following pages.


The Polaris Inset has a convection chamber which allows cold air to enter below the stove and pass up through the chamber whilst warming up and then re-enters the room through vents above the stove door creating an increased efficiency.

The mantelpiece shown is the elegant Kensington in natural Slate Stone (our Slate Stone Gallery is shown on page 43 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). This mantel is also available in Turkish limestone and Spanish Crema Marfil marble.

The hearth and back panel are shown in honed Shanxi black granite, offering a nice contrast to the polished stove outer band. The hearth is in our Munro design and is sectioned for solid fuel to allow for expansion.


POLARIS INTEGRA *with* ARCHED INSERTS

The Polaris Integra is a traditional arched or tiled cast-iron insert integrated with our Polaris Integra Inset Eco multi-fuel stove. This combination gives the appearance of a classic cast-iron fireplace of yesteryear but uniquely it incorporates one of the most efficient and contemporary wood burning stoves on the market today.


Designed in the UK, this fireplace is sturdy, practical and sports a convector chamber, a wide screen for viewing, a riddling action which shakes ash into the ashpan and has the option of a removable handle, making it safer to open the stove door before the stove has cooled down.

With a nominal heat output up to 5kW (therefore no additional air vent required in your room) we are confident to offer a 10-year conditional warranty on this stove excluding internal consumable parts.

The Polaris Integra Inset Eco multi-fuel stove complies with EcoDesign 2022 regulations and with its high efficiency and low carbon emissions is allowed by DEFRA to be used in smoke-controlled areas across the UK for the burning of seasoned wood and HETAS approved smokeless fuels. The Polaris Royal is a plain arched cast-iron insert with a simple bead design inside the outer arch. The Royal has a matt black finish and integrates perfectly with the matt black Polaris Integra Inset fitting snugly into a dedicated opening inside the external cast-iron fascia. POLARIS REGAL

The Polaris Regal is a plain arched cast-iron insert with the outer arch polished. The Regal fascia fits snugly with the Polaris Integra Inset stove, which is also polished on the outer arch, creating a double polished arch look. Key stove facts can be found on page 33.

The mantelpiece shown is the Durham shown here in Spanish Crema Marfil (our Crema Marfil Gallery is shown on page 44 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). The hearth is honed Shanxi Granite in our Munro style and we recommend that it be sectioned for solid fuel to allow for expansion. See hearths on page 45.



POLARIS ASHBOURNE

The Polaris Ashbourne is a decorative arched cast-iron insert with the outer arch polished and therefore highlighting the intricate detail. The Ashbourne fascia integrates with the Polaris Integra Inset stove, which is also polished on the outer arch, creating a double polished arch look. The Ashbourne is also available matt black. Key stove facts can be found on page 33.

The mantelpiece shown is the Victorian Corbel in Turkish limestone (our Turkish Limestone Gallery is shown on page 41 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). The hearth is honed Shanxi Granite in our Munro style and we recommend that it be sectioned for solid fuel to allow for expansion. Hearths are shown on page 45.


POLARIS INTEGRA *with* TILED INSERTS

The Polaris Integra is a traditional arched or tiled cast-iron insert integrated with our Polaris Integra Inset Eco multi-fuel stove. This combination gives the appearance of a classic cast-iron fireplace of yesteryear but uniquely it incorporates one of the most efficient and contemporary wood burning stoves on the market today.

Our tiled inserts are designed in the UK and manufactured in the traditional way. The Polaris has three tiled insert options, a movable canopy being the difference between the Aston, Eden and Art Nouveau models. Tiled inserts require a set of ten heat resistant tiles (five either side) or a set (pair) of cast-iron sleeves.

A unique convector chamber brings additional heat to your room that would have traditionally disappeared up the chimney. A removable stove door handle makes it safer to open the stove door before the stove has cooled down.

With a nominal heat output up to 5kW (therefore no additional air vent required in your room) the Polaris Integra Inset Eco multi-fuel stove complies with EcoDesign 2022 regulations and its high efficiency and low carbon emissions allow it to be used in smoke-controlled areas by DEFRA for the burning of seasoned wood and HETAS approved smokeless fuels. 

The Eden has a matt black finish and integrates perfectly with the matt black Polaris Integra Inset fitting snugly into a dedicated opening inside the external cast-iron fascia. The mantelpiece shown is the Flat Victorian shown here in traditional Italian Carrara marble. (Our Italian Carrara Gallery is shown on page 42 and mantel dimensions are shown on page 40). The hearth is honed Shanxi Granite in our Munro style and we recommend that it be sectioned for solid fuel to allow for expansion. See hearths on page 45. Inglenook Panels are fire resistant boards with natural riven stone pieces attached to the fascia. These panels come in two materials, Grey Slate and Oyster Marble.

Three panels are required to fit into a standard inglenook chamber, one large (for the rear) and two small (for the sides). Alternatively, one large panel could be fitted to the rear of the opening only as shown on page 17.



KESWICK SHELVES

The Keswick is an attractive shelf with corbels ideally suited to be placed as a feature in any room (i.e. above a fireplace inglenook as shown on page 17). The Keswick is available with a light stain in Solid Oak but may be available without a finish upon request.





STONE MANTELPieces

The CastTec Stove Collection offers a stunning range of pure stone mantelpieces in materials such as Turkish Limestone, Italian Carrara Marble, Spanish Crema Marfil, Slate Stone and Shanxi Black Granite.

For those wanting a traditional design, we have the timeless Flat Victorian design, the standard Victorian Corbel and the elegant William IV and Corinthian.

For those wanting a more contemporary feel, the Kensington and Hexham fill that brief with the Cotswold coming somewhere in between.

The Chilton is interesting, as it is basically a Flat Victorian mantel, however, the edges have a nice, rounded bullnose edge, a perfect match for our Munro granite hearths.


Mantelpieces are available in two shelf sizes, 1350mm (53") and/or 1500mm (59").

Fire Cement

Stove Paint

Cast Tec Stove Paint (400ml) is a fast drying high temperature (up to 650C) paint for use on wood, heat resistant boards, stoves, cast-iron fires, cookers & chimineas.

Stove Fan is a small environmentally friendly four blade fan which sits on top of your stove. Self powered (using the heat from your stove) the fan needs no batteries or electricity.



The benefit from our stove fan comes when it circulates warm air generated from your stove (which normally rises up therefore potentially using less fuel. The fan

operates quietly, has a discreet black satin finish and is suitable for temperatures up to 300 C.



Moisture Meter

Stoves purchased from 1st January 2017 onwards will be subject to a 10

year extended warranty which will exclude consumable products such as stove glass, rope seal, firebricks, grates and ash-pans. To qualify you will need to provide proof of purchase from an authorised stockist, proof of installation by a qualified heating engineer (HETAS registered) along with a regular service record and compliance with the product User Instructions (i.e. type of fuels to use, chimney sweep frequency etc.).

Discolouration or paint peeling may occur to the finish of a cast-iron stove if it comes into contact with a naked flame or where the heat is very intense after the burning of certain fuels (i.e. petroleum based coals). If this occurs it can usually be remedied by applying a heat resistant spray paint to the affected area. The

use of damp or unseasoned wood or man-made wood alternatives (chipboard, plywood etc.) may cause the stove interior, glass and flue to develop excessive carbon and tar deposits.
